Rules & Regulations

- ◆ Visiting hours are from sunrise to sunset.
- ◆ Uneven ground, walk at your own risk.
- ◆ Lake Township is not liable for damage to monuments, markers, vases, and landscaping caused by ordinary care and maintenance of cemetery.
- ◆ Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- ◆ No pets are allowed.
- ◆ No loitering, alcoholic beverages or excessive noise are permitted.
- ◆ No parking or driving on grass at any time.
- ◆ All trash must be placed in trash receptacles.
- ◆ No trees, shrubs, rosebushes, perennials or invasive plantings of any kind are allowed without prior approval of the Lake Township Board of Trustees.
- ◆ Annual flowers may be planted at the base of the memorial stone. Flowerbeds shall not exceed the width of the memorial stone, nor extend more than 12 inches in front of the stone. All plantings are to be maintained by lot owner and/or agent. Plantings not maintained or deemed an eyesore may be removed at the discretion of the Trustees or Cemetery Supervisor.
- ◆ Fences, hedges, curbing and enclosures of any kind around lots or graves are prohibited.
- ◆ Fresh cut flowers and decorations will be removed from gravesites when they become unsightly. Glass containers are not permitted.
- ◆ Flowers and decorations placed for burials will be left in place for at least one week after the burial.
- ◆ Winter wreaths are permitted from November 15 to March 15 after which time they will be removed by cemetery maintenance.
- ◆ Maximum of two burials per grave site, only one of which can be a full burial.
- ◆ All full burials require a vault.
- ◆ All markers must fit within the boundaries of the grave space including the required 4" foundation border, headstones may be flush or above grade, but all footstones must be flush with the ground.

PLEASE NOTE

No more than two (2) remains shall be buried in a single burial space; a single full burial, a full burial and a single cremation burial **with the full burial occurring first**, or two (2) cremation burials. All full burials require a vault. All markers must fit within the boundaries of the grave space including the required foundation border, headstones may be flush or above grade, but all footstones must be flush with the ground.

Foundations are poured twice a year – cut off dates are March 31st and September 15th
