WHEREAS, upon due investigation and consideration, the board has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation in and for the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five (5) years will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs; within the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (I), for the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, by reason thereof, this board has determined that it will be necessary to levy a *replacement of an existing one (1.0) mill tax levy and an increase of one-half (0.50) mill to constitute a one and one-half (1.50) mill tax levy* for providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section <u>145.48</u> or <u>742.34</u> of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs; within the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (I); and

WHEREAS, by reason of the facts above set forth, this board has determined that it should, and hereby does, declare itself to submit to the electors of the Lake

Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, at the Primary election to be held May 8, 2018, the question of levying a replacement of an existing one (1.0) mill levy and an increase of one-half (0.50) mill to constitute a one and onehalf (1.50) mill tax levy for providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs; within the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (I); at the Primary election to be held on May 8, 2018, for a period not to exceed five (5) years, being tax years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be submitted to the electors of the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, at the **Primary election** on May 8, 2018, the question of a replacement of an existing one (1.0) mill levy and an increase of one-half (0.50) mill to constitute a one and one-half (1.50) mill tax levy for providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs; within the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.19 (I); at the Primary election to be held on May 8, 2018., and that said replacement and additional tax constituting one and one-half (1.50) mills shall be levied for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2018 and first due in 2019, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the submission of said proposal, the notice of election, the form of ballot, the certification of the levy as voted outside the ten (10) mill limitation, and the levying of such renewed millage shall be in accordance with the provisions of Sections 5705.19 (I), 5705.191, 5705.192, and 5705.25 and other related Sections of the Revised Code of Ohio and in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the form of ballot cast at such election shall be:

<u>PROPOSED TAX LEVY –</u> (<u>REPLACEMENT AND ADDITIONAL TAX</u>) LAKE TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT, LAKE TOWNSHIP

A majority Affirmative Vote is Necessary for Passage.

A replacement of an existing one (1.0) mill tax levy and an increase of one-half (0.50) mill to constitute a one and one-half (1.50) mill tax levy for the benefit of the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township for providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs; for the Lake Township Fire District, Lake Township, Stark County, Ohio at a rate not exceeding one and onehalf (1.5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifteen cents (\$ (0.15) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019.
